### **MENTAL HEALTH AND VANDALISM**

These items, both of which were raised at the Liberal Democrat Spring Conference this March, are linked in more ways than one. Mental Health and Police Services are both victims of the austerity cuts and vandalism is often caused by mental health issues.

Nationally the Lib Dems are campaigning for mental health to be given the same priority as physical health and are calling for an all party working group to take this issue out of party politics. Locally Councillor lan Wilkes is doing his bit supporting Audley as a dementia friendly society.

## **LOCAL PLAN AND HOUSING**

The Newcastle Local Plan calls for more houses than needed, at building rates far higher than have been achieved recently.

It leaves sites for 2000 houses unidentified which opens the door to developers submit sites all over the Green Belt.

Sites such as those in Wood Lane could be at risk.

Cllr. Ian Wilkes and the Lib Dems are campaigning for the Council to use modular

construction to speed up and make greener the house building programme.


